Fishing from the Shore By Bill Hall

Just as angling action started to improve, along comes a major weather system up the coast producing tropical conditions on Tuesday. How this will impact the fishing is anybody's guess.

Prior to the arrival of the system, puppy drum had started to appear in the seaside creeks, along with snapper bluefish in the creeks and along the surf. The population of spot was increasing on a daily basis on the bayside, as were speckled trout. I don't anticipate the system hurting the lower bayside red drum fishery, although it could start to wind up this year's fantastic cobia run.

Chincoteague - Donna Rae, at Captain Bob's Marina, reported that small bluefish in the 10-14" range have moved into Assateague and Chincoteague Channels as well as the Assateague Surf. These snappers are hitting almost anything, but fresh cut bait has been the top producer. Spot catches were being made in the surf on bloodworm and bloodworm-flavored Fishbites. Flounder

catches improved prior to Tuesday's blow, keeper-sized fish from Chincoteague Channel as well as along Sound Bridge, where a few keeper trout were

encountered. Closer to the inlet, puffers and sea mullet (kingfish, whiting) were still available. The same area remains a hotbed for catching coastal sharks. The subway cars produced nice catches of flounder in the 22-25" class earlier in the week, but fell off over the weekend. Captain Steve's Bait & Tackle weighed in flounder up to 6.10. Triggers and trout were a welcome bycatch of the deepwater flounder fishery. Catches of dolphin (mahi) were made over the Bone Wreck. Maryland angler Brent Redmiles trolled up a 5-14 Spanish mackerel while pulling a Clark Spoon two miles off the Assateague shoreline.

Wachapreague - Capt. Lindsay Paul, at Trident Tackle, reported that the Foxy Lady, with Captain Nat Atkinson, found yellowfin tuna and a king mackerel in the vicinity of 21 Mile Hill. Another vessel trolling the same seamount was rewarded with three yellowfin and a wahoo. Captain Paul said that couple of white marlin releases were made in the Washington Canyon. Inside the inlet, a steady population of croakers had moved in, although most of them were on the small side. Inshore anglers were also catching sand mullet (whiting), puppy drum and mostly undersized flounder.

Lower Shore - Chis Snook, of Chris' Bait & Tackle, reported that spot catches were improving off Kiptopeke, where a nice population of kingfish (whiting) was still hanging out. Catches of over 300 whiting per boat was reported, according to Chris. Along the Chesapeake Bay Bridge-Tunnel, sheepshead catches were improving, while the population of triggerfish and spadefish remained steady. Large red drum were being released over the shoals, while cobia were still being caught by sightcasters, though the fish were becoming more finicky after being targeted all summer. Puppy drum catches were reported along the lower shore seaside creeks.

Upper Chesapeake Bay – Speckled trout action continued to improve in the middle bay, primarily from Watts Island up to Smith Island and South Marsh. Parksley's Ethan Willett registered a citation 5-5 speckled trout at Don's Tackle Shop. Some larger rockfish, to almost 30 inches, were encountered by bait anglers inside Tangier Sound, off the Manokin River. Farther down the bay, large red drum from 40 to more than 50 inches in length were being caught and released from off Occohannock Creek down to Cape Charles. If you enjoy fishing on the Chesapeake, make plans now to enter

the 27th Annual Onancock Bay Challenge Fishing Tournament on Sept. 16. Eight different bay species will be eligible for first and second place catches in both adult and youth divisions. For more information, log on to www.esanglersclub.org or call 757-709-8697.


